OUR PROGRAM

- \$30/hr. Minimum Wage tied to the cost of living.
- We oppose all comp time and forced overtime.
- We support the right of all workers to strike. Repeal of all anti-strike laws. Remove all no-strike clauses from contracts.
- We support the right of all workers to organize their workplaces.
- We demand an expansion of all prevailing wage laws.
- Repeal all anti-worker laws, including a full repeal of Taft-Hartley, the Railway Labor Act and end all "right to work" laws. We demand improved working conditions for all workers.
- Nationalization of the railroads under workers' control.
- End all child labor!
- Free Vocational and University training.
- A "National Health Service" covering all people.
- 30 hr. work week with 40 hour pay.
- Elimination of the arbitrary cap on income contributions to Social Security.
- We fully support the struggle for trade union and democratic freedoms.
- An economic transformation of military production to peace time infrastructure development.
- We oppose state violence, terrorism, and persecution of trade unionists and defend the rights of all workers to fight back against fascism and racism.
